Introduction

The second edition of the Safety Case Symposium: *Technologies, Methodologies and Regulations* will be held from 26th to 27th March 2019 in Singapore.

The key objective of the Safety Case Symposium is to provide a dedicated platform where global stakeholders of safety cases convene to engage in sharing, learning and discussion on *Safety Case* related topics.

Organized in collaboration with **National University of Singapore (NUS)**, **Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT)**, **UON Singapore** (a wholly-owned entity of *The University of Newcastle, Australia*) and **TÜV Rheinland** as the technical partners, the symposium aims to bring the best-in-class Safety Case ideas to the participants. The first edition in 2018 has gathered over 230 participants from 15 countries globally.

First established in the United Kingdom, the Safety Case Regime has been widely adopted by regulators in many countries. They include Denmark, Netherlands, Australia, Brunei, and Singapore which have adopted similar regimes for their Major Accident Hazard Facilities.

Topics & Scope of Paper

All topics shall address safety/security regulators, process industries or other Major Accident Hazard Facilities. We welcome submissions from safety professionals, university and research institutes, standards development bodies, engineering communities and other relevant stakeholders of safety case regime.

- Speakers shall present the developments and trends of state-of-the-art technologies, best engineering practices, in-depth methodology arguments, latest regulations/standards update, or other relevant topics in Safety Case within the context of Singapore and/or global market.
- Paper/Presentation will **not** be accepted if it includes only:
 - the fundamentals of Safety Case, and/or
 - sales elements about products and services

The Symposium will be held in English.

Submission of Executive Summary

Authors are requested to submit an executive summary (up to 3 pages) in English.

- Receipt of summary: by **January 8th, 2019**
- Notification of acceptance: by **January 29th, 2019**
- Receipt of final papers and presentations: by **March 5th, 2019**

Final Papers and Presentations

- Final papers should not exceed 8 pages and be submitted as MS WORD file.
- Presentations (duration: 30-45min) shall be in MS POWERPOINT. Template will be provided.

Each speaker will receive one additional complementary ticket to the Symposium.

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Submission of Paper – a Guide to Preparing Full Paper

First A. Author and Second B. Author

Abstract: The paper and abstract must be written in English and submitted in MSWORD format. The abstract should offer a concise summary of the paper and no more than 250 words.

Keywords: keywords in lower case separated by commas, finishing with a full-stop.

1 Introduction

2 Structure of the document

The paper should be arranged in the following order: title, authors, affiliation, corresponding author, abstract, keywords, body of the paper subdivided under suitable headings, beginning with an introduction and finishing with conclusions, acknowledgements, references and presenting author biography.

3 Conclusions and recommendations

The real value of a paper is reflected in the nature, soundness and clarity of the conclusions, so particular care should be taken with this section.

Acknowledgements

If appropriate, include a short paragraph acknowledging any special support provided by third parties.

References
